This document must be submitted as part of a Building Consent Application as an Alternative Solution. For the purpose of this document LVT refers to both Luxury Vinyl Tile and Luxury Vinyl Plank.

E3.3.1 An adequate combination of thermal resistance, ventilation, and space temperature must be provided to all habitable spaces, bathrooms, laundries, and other areas where moisture may be generated or may accumulate.

E3.3.2 Freewater from accidental overflow from sanitary fixtures or sanitary appliances must be disposed of in a way that avoids loss of amenity or damage to household units or other property.

We believe the above clause relates more to building and plumbing design and should be discussed with the applicable trades. We recommend that Gilt Edge Industries flooring systems (floor preparation products and adhesives) are used in conjunction with Robert Malcolm LVT products to satisfy NZBC E3.3.2 in relation to flooring. Gilt Edge Industries product details can be found in the links below. Our LVT products contain a urethane top surface that is impervious. When coupled with the correct Gilt Edge Industries flooring system, we believe they meet the criteria for an Alternative Solution.

E3.3.3 Floor surfaces of any space containing sanitary fixtures or sanitary appliances must be impervious and easily cleaned.

E3.3.4 Wall surfaces adjacent to sanitary fixtures or sanitary appliances must be impervious and easily cleaned.

As per the FloorNZ best practise guidelines all Robert Malcolm LVT installed within 1.5m of any sanitary fixture or sanitary appliances must have a silicone or flexible sealant applied to the junction of any vertical surface to seal the junction and prevent water splash penetrating any wall lining.

E3.3.5 Surfaces of building elements likely to be splashed or become contaminated in the course of the intended use of the building, must be impervious and easily cleaned.

The top surface of Robert Malcolm's LVT products has a durable urethane top layer that is impervious. Couple this, with the correct Gilt Edge Industries Ltd. installation system we believe this product meets the criteria for an Alternative Solution. This is backed up by testing carried out by NZWTA, an independent testing body based in Napier, New Zealand.
